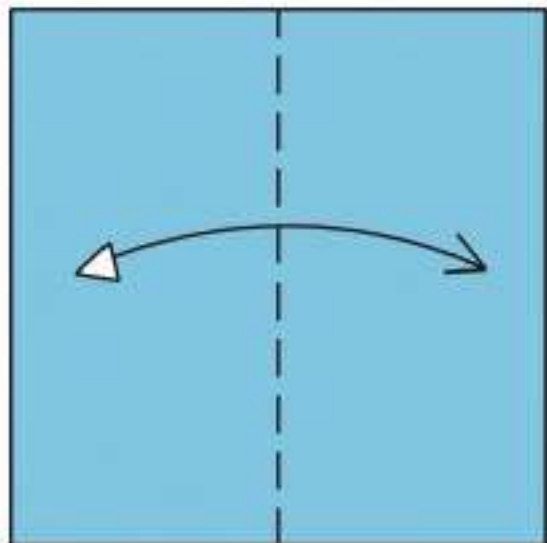


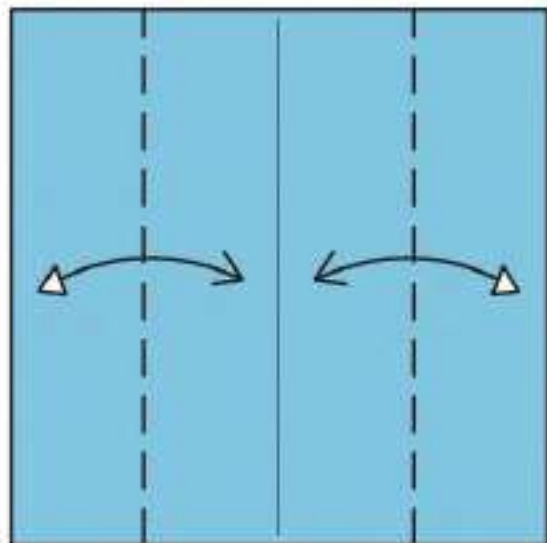

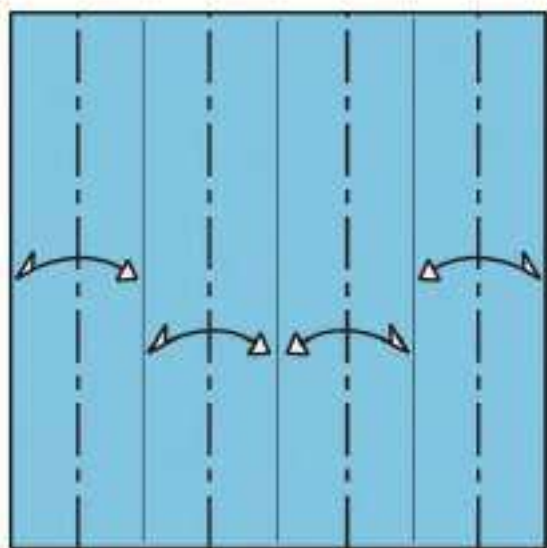




1. Precrease in half.

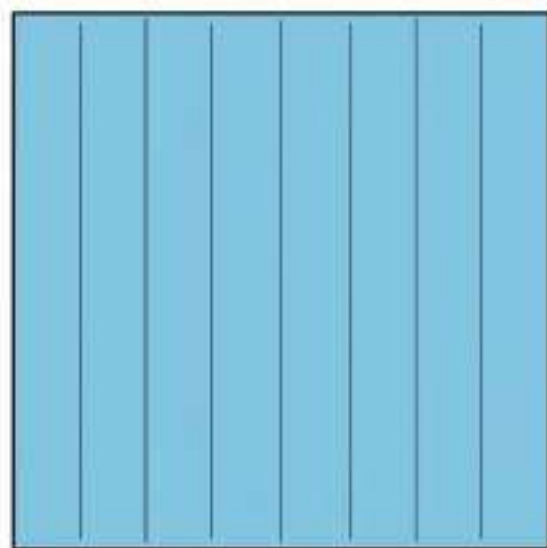


2. Precrease the sides in half.

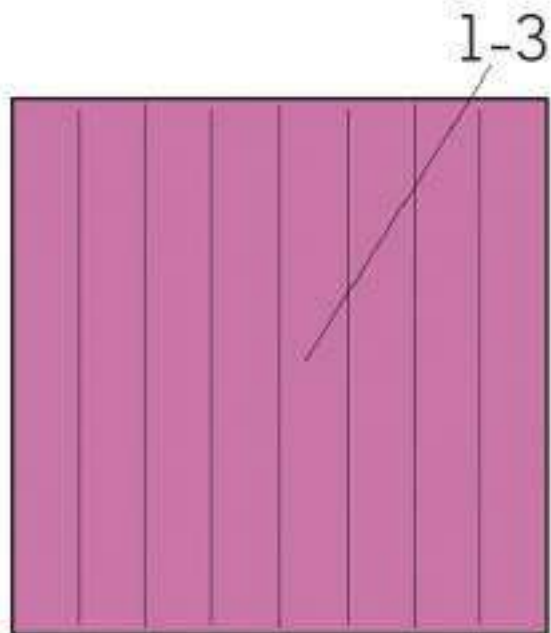


3. Precrease each section in half with a mountain fold.

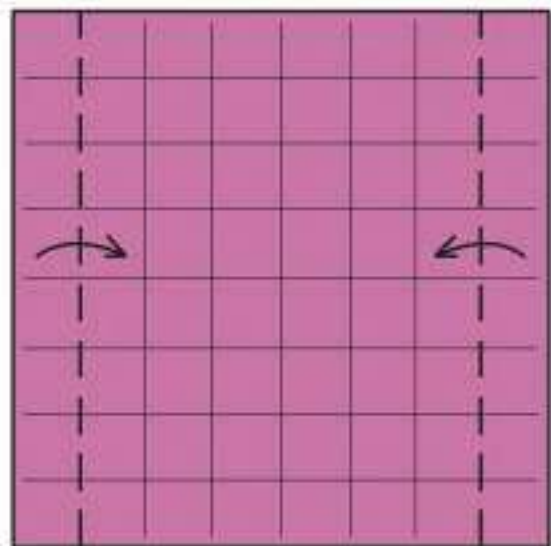

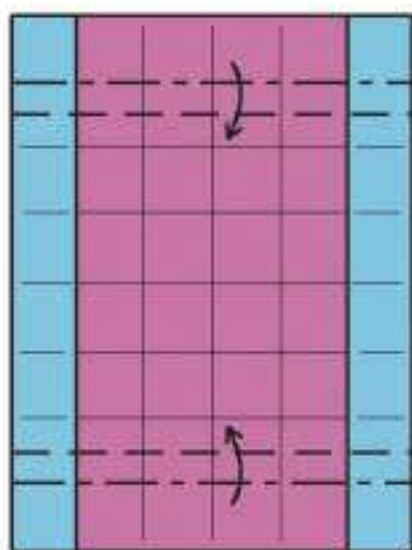
4. Turn over.



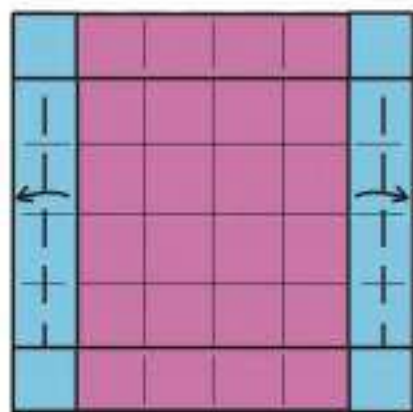
5. Repeat steps 1-3 horizontally.



6. Valley fold the sides inwards.

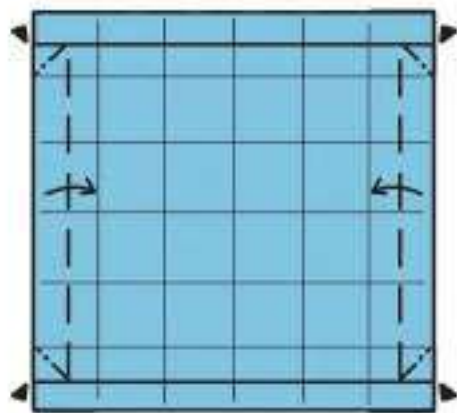
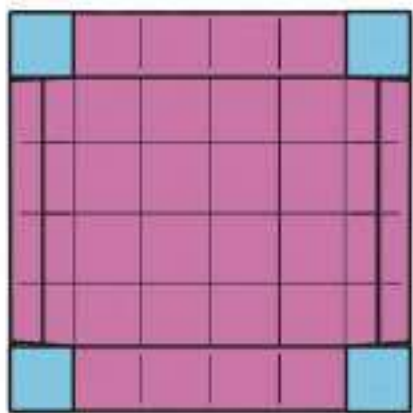


7. Pleat inwards to meet the existing creases.



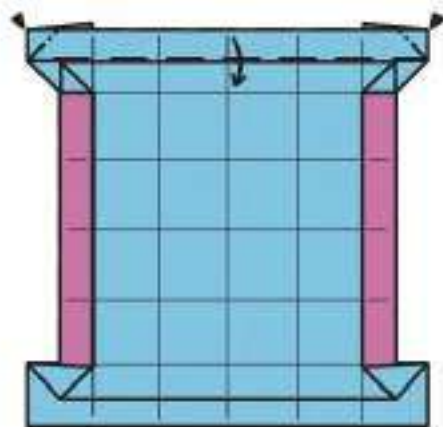
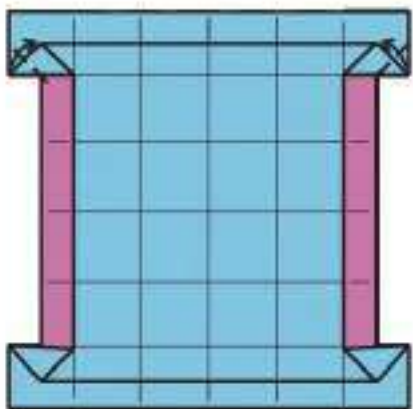
8. Valley fold the edges outwards, allowing swivels to form.

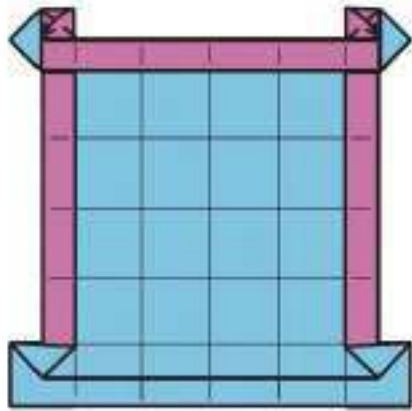
9. Turn over.

10. Valley fold the sides inwards, allowing the corners to squash.

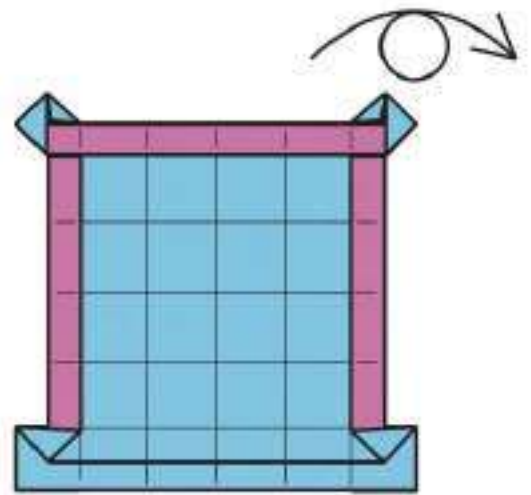


11. Valley fold the corners inwards.

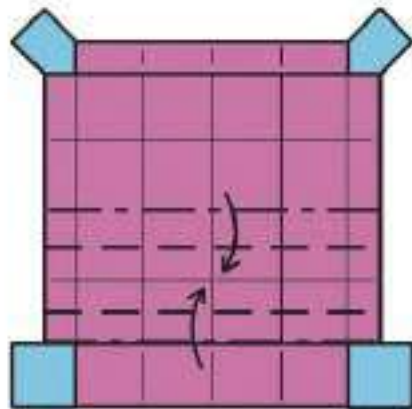
12. Valley fold the edge down, allowing the corners to squash.



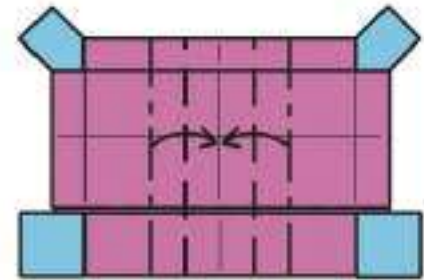
13. Valley fold the corners inwards.



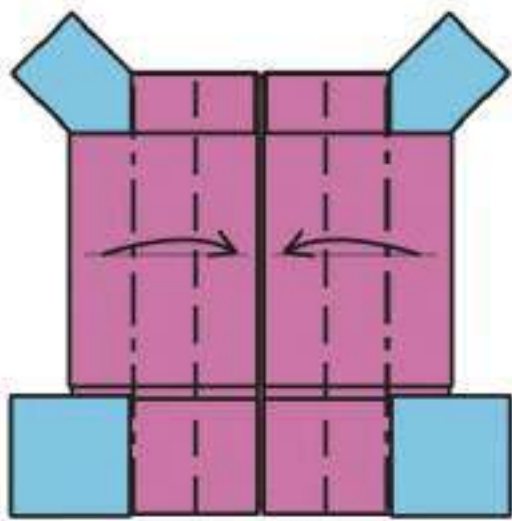
14. Turn over.



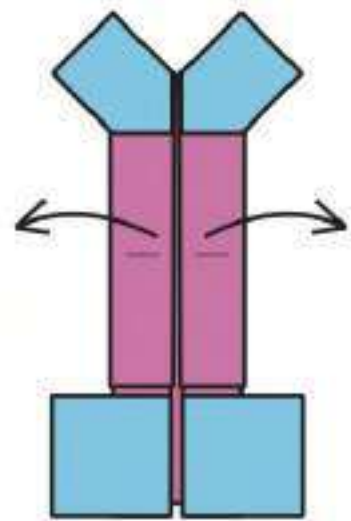
15. Pleat inwards towards the crease.



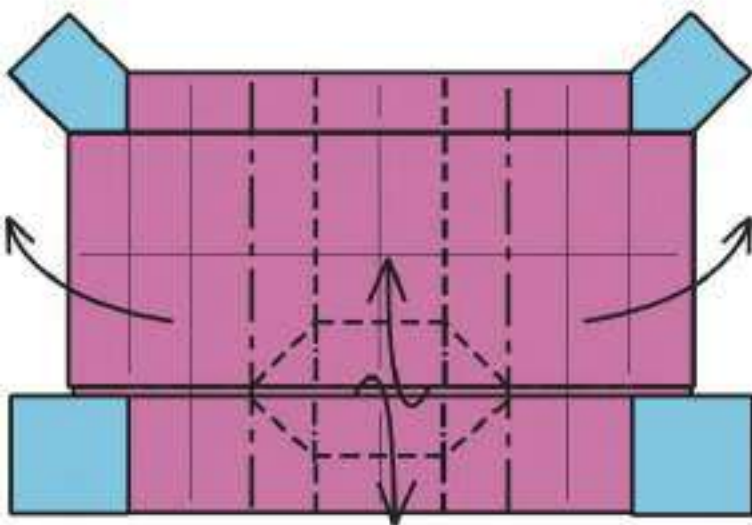
16. Pleat the sides towards the center.



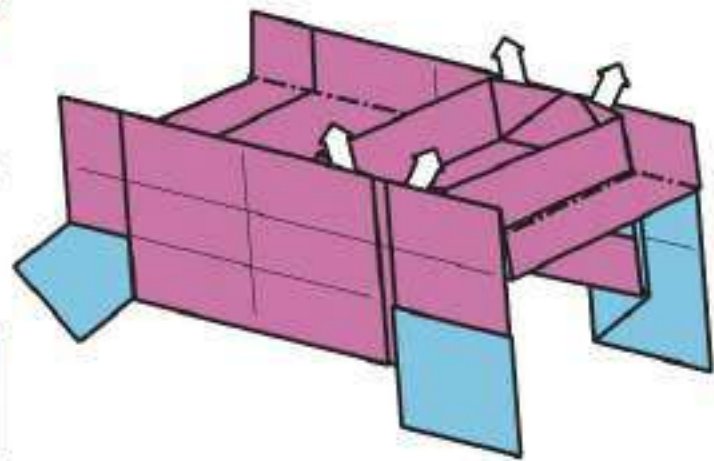
17. Pleat the sides towards the center.



18. Unfold the two sets of pleats.

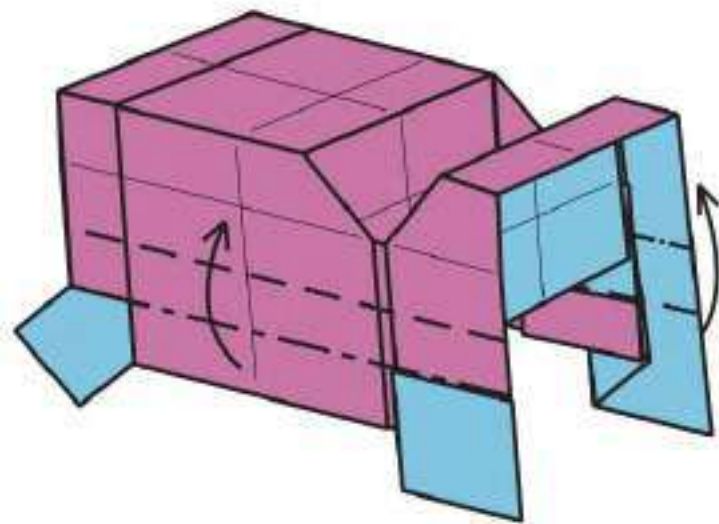


19. Bring the sides down while bringing all of the center layers up. The model will be 3-D.

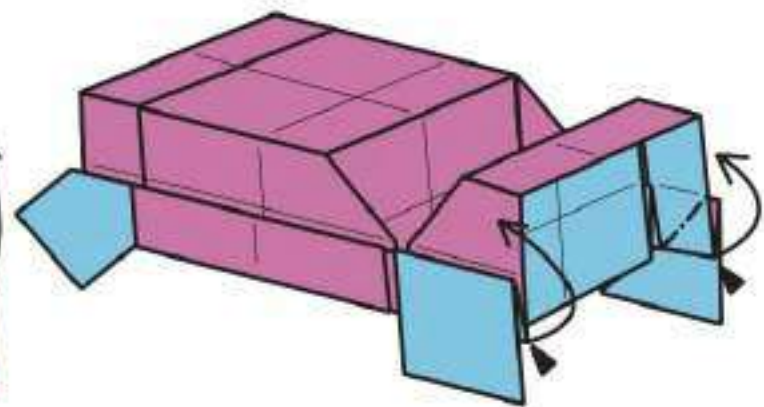


20. Invert the front and back sections up.

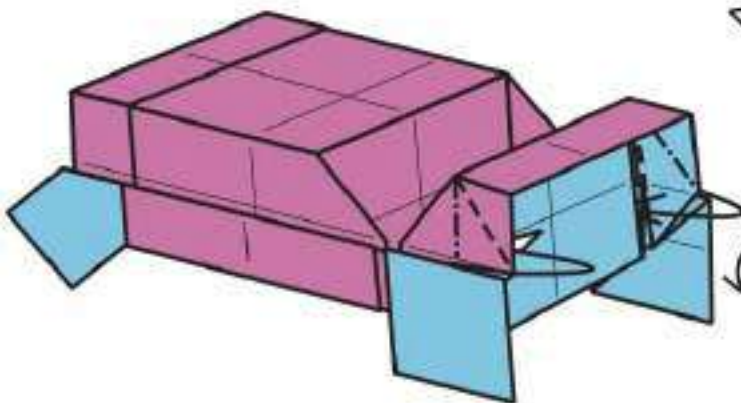

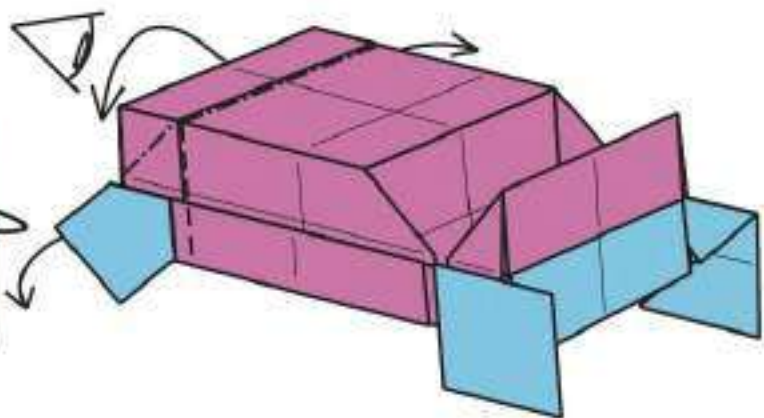
21. Pleat the sides up along the existing creases.



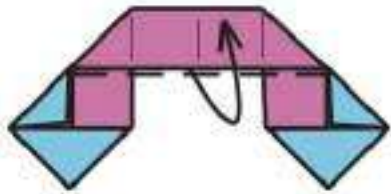
22. Reverse fold the corners.



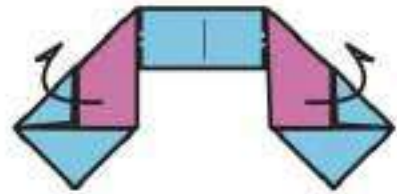
23. Reverse fold the flaps into the pockets.



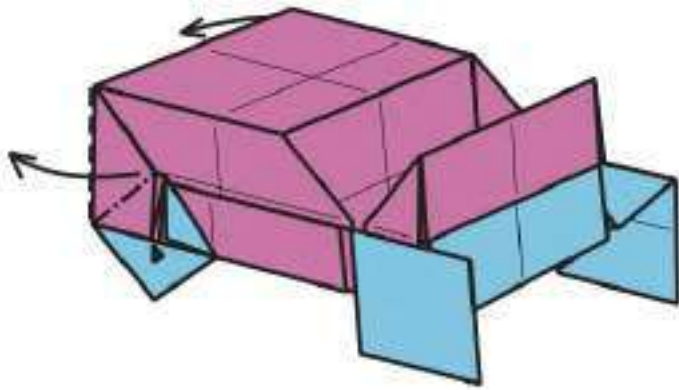
24. Reverse fold the edge down while swinging the sides outwards.



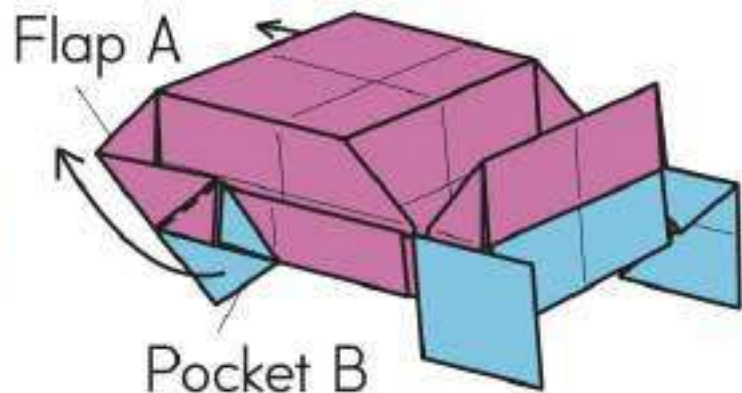
25. View from previous step. Wrap around a single layer.



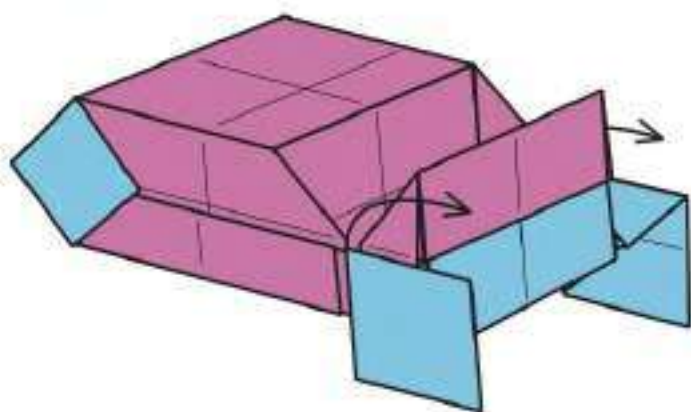
26. Swing the sides back.



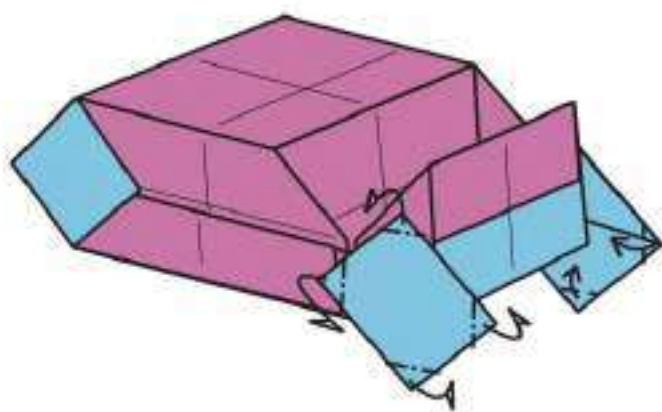
27. Valley fold the flaps forward, allowing squashes to form.



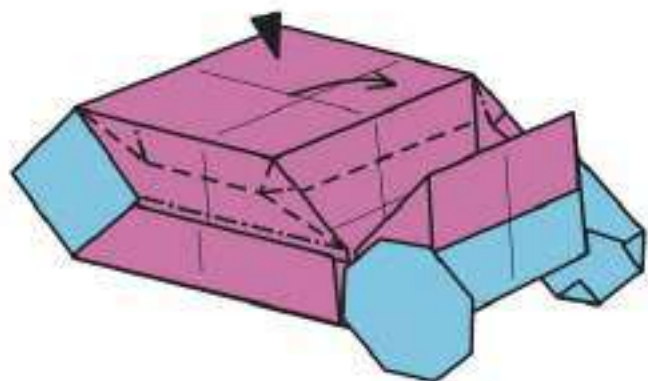
28. Valley fold the flaps forward, tucking flaps A into pockets B.



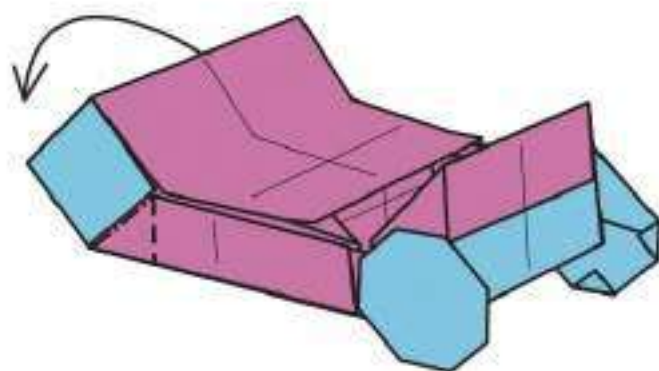
29. Rotate the square flaps.



30. Mountain fold the corners.

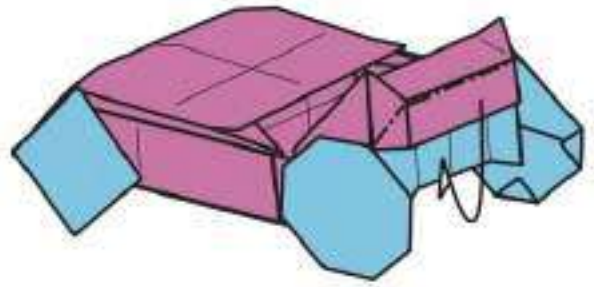
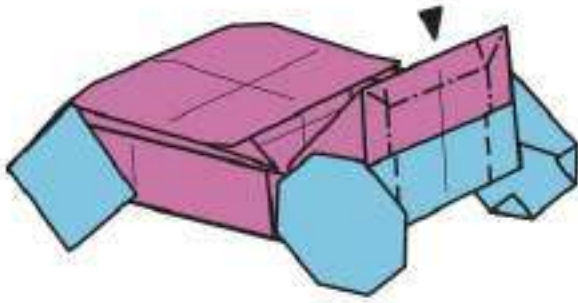


31. Collapse the top section down by inserting a rabbit ear along the sides.



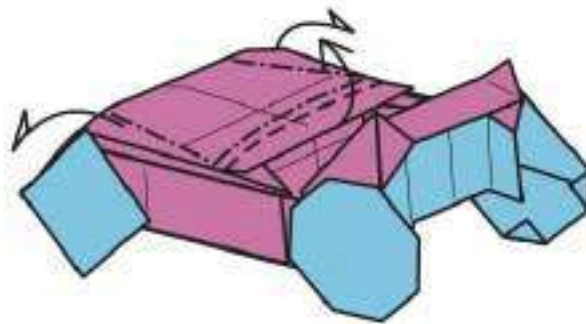
32. Crimp the sides, allowing the front to rotate down.

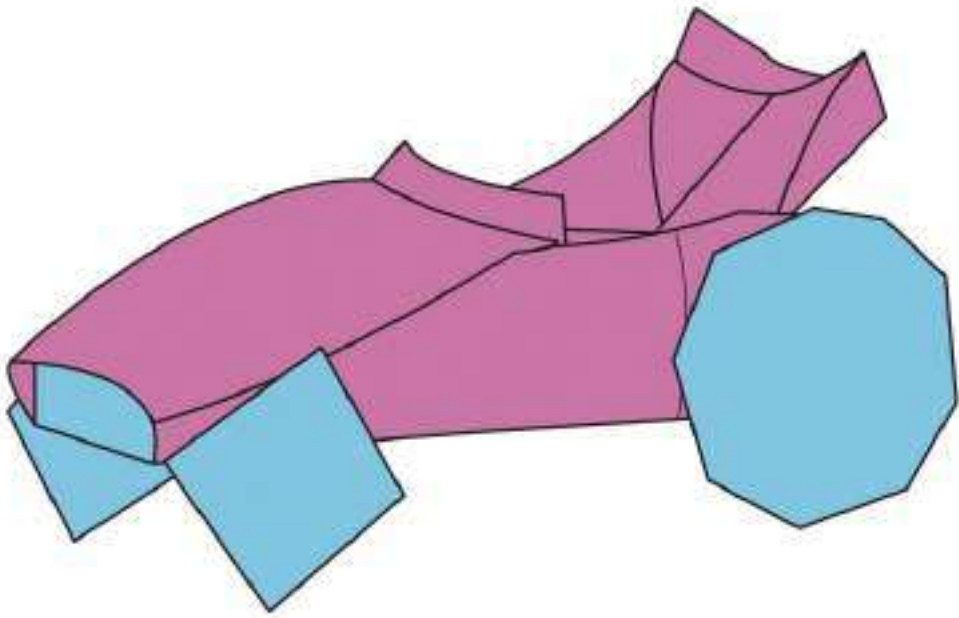


33. Open out the back and pinch the upper corners. You will have to push the sides in slightly to accomplish this.

34. Reverse fold the edge.



35. Crimp the windshield up, round the sides down, and crimp the grill down to taste (not shown).



36. Completed *Dune Buggy*.
