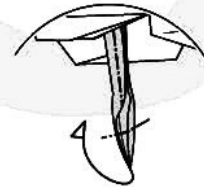
Spread 3 layers apart near the tip of the flap.

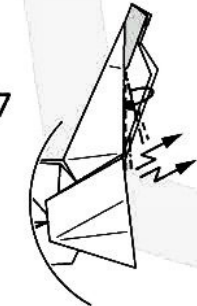
The foot should look like this. Rotate the foot 90 degrees. Pleat the back toe.

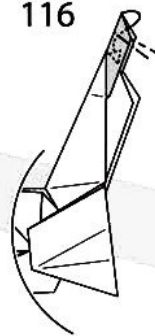
Fold the tip of the flap back to form the front edge of the feet. Shape the leg and three front toes.

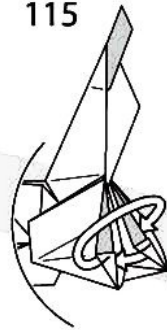
Crimp the neck and hide some paper under the front layer.

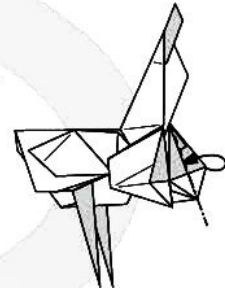


Reverse fold the tip of the beak inside.

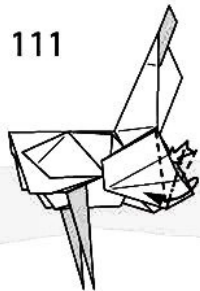

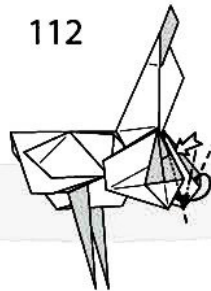

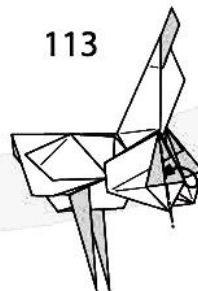
Symmetrical squash fold.

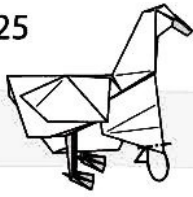

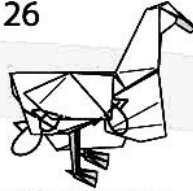

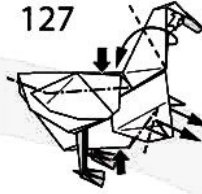
Fold the tip of the chest flap inside to lock it together.
