

Gaff's Blade Runner Chicken

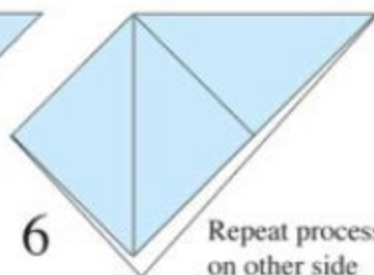
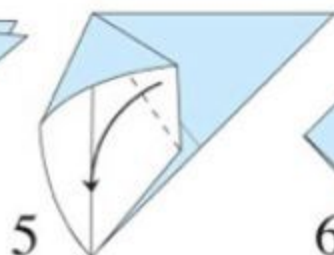
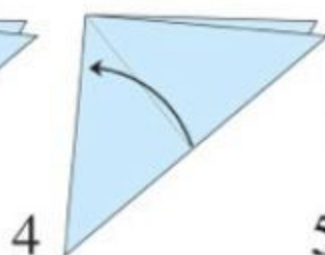
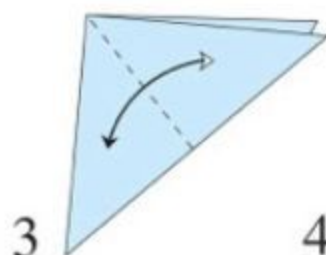
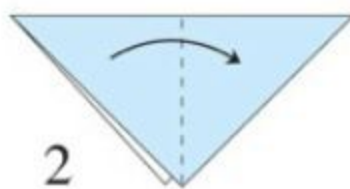
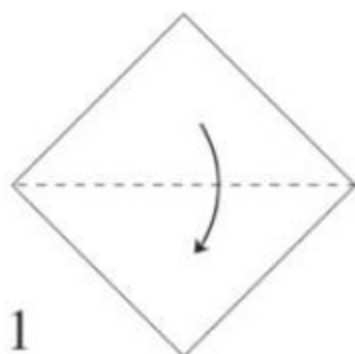

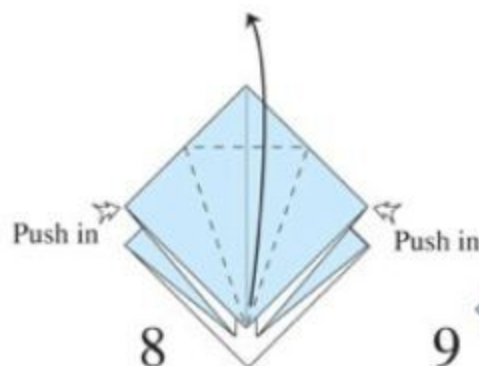
- 1) 1 pieces of 3 inch square white paper.



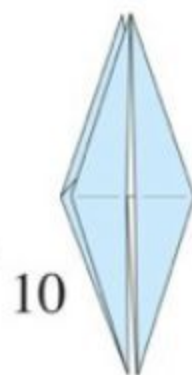
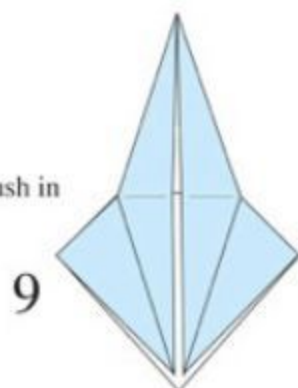
Repeat process on other side



Fold and unfold along the dotted lines

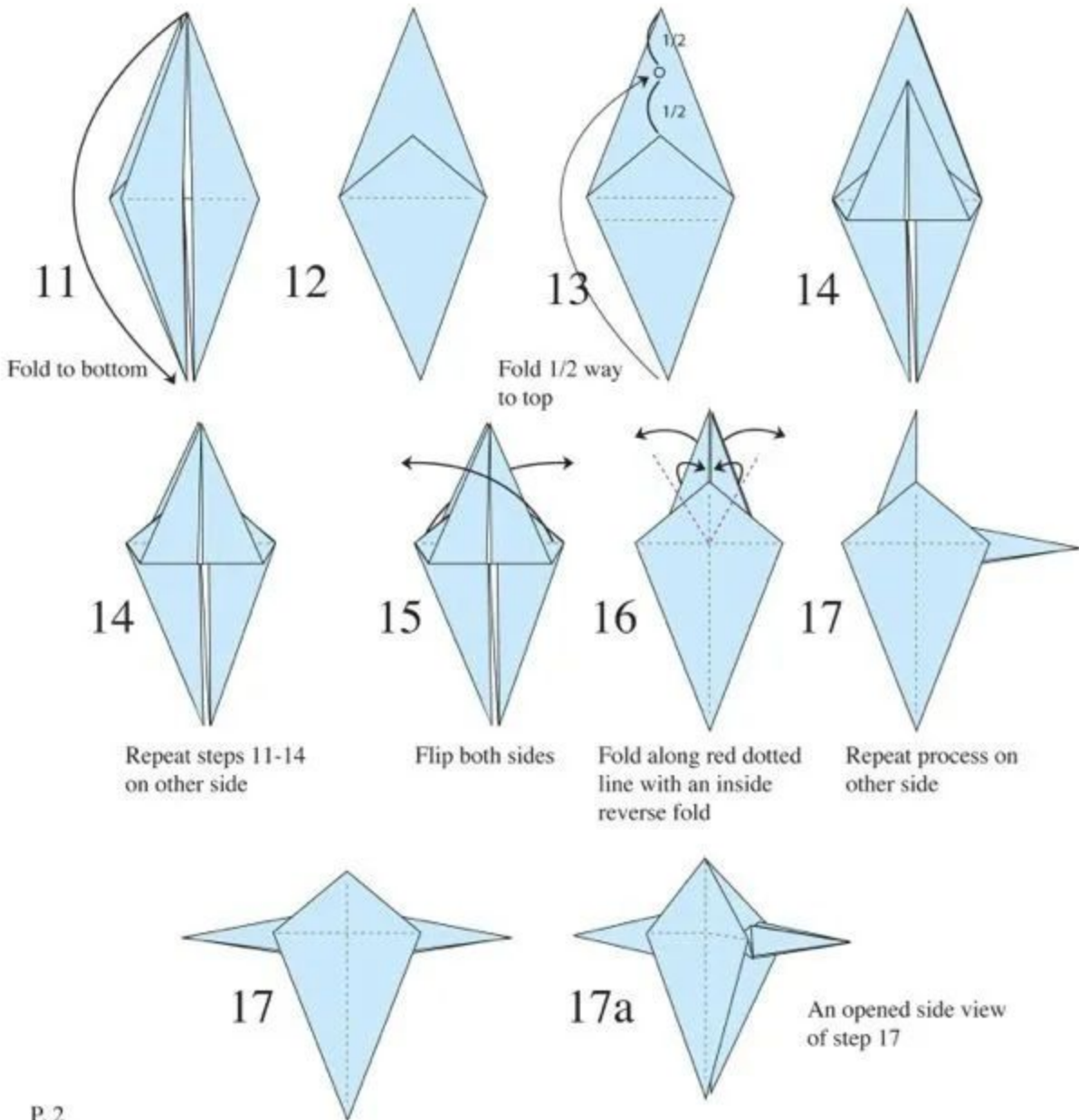


(Petal-fold) Pull up to top point and fold



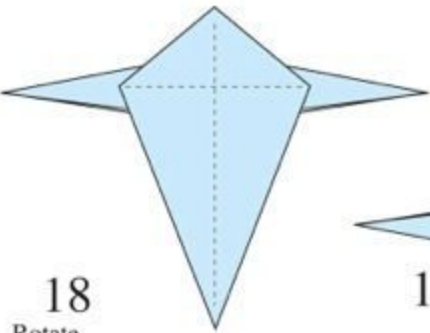

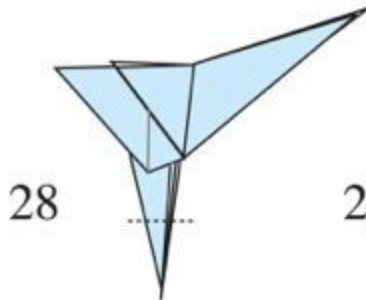
Fold down along dotted lines in (step 27), while at the same time folding the body in half (step 28). You are pulling the legs together.

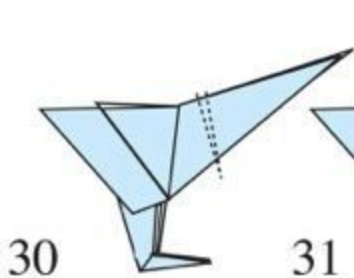

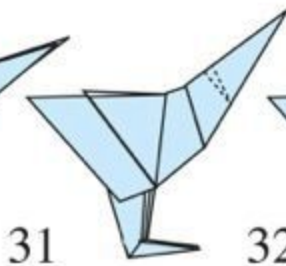
Side view.



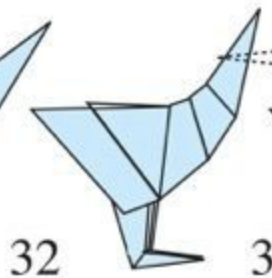
Fold feet forward



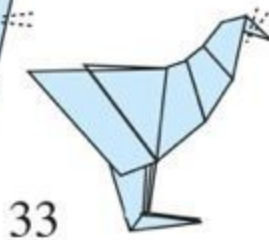

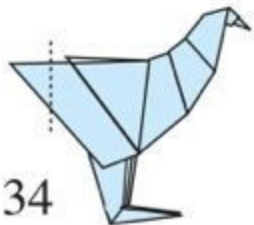
